Overview of Traineeship programme

- 12 week government funded employability programme for 16-24 year olds
- 120 hours of work experience in a placement of their choice
- Support & develop employability skills for the workplace
- Maths and English Qualifications (if haven't already got GCSE grades A – C)
- In 18 months 146 YP's have completed the programme with 68% going into positive pathways.



Why this programme is important in Blackpool

Education - Blackpool GCSE below national levels with a low proportion achieving 5 or more A* to C grade GCSEs (53.2% compared to 63.8%).

In addition, approximately 7% of Blackpool's young people are not in education, employment or training compared to 5% for the North - West.

Community Inclusion - In terms of workforce, Blackpool has a low employment rate at 64.9% compared to a national rate of 72.4%.

32% of adults in Blackpool are unemployed and an estimated 13.0% of the working age population in Blackpool have no formal qualifications. whilst 14.5% of over 16 year olds have no qualifications from further education or school.
