BLACKPOOL'S FULL FIBRE PLAN

- The North Atlantic Loop will come through Blackpool
- New York – Ireland – Blackpool – Denmark
- Internet speed from Blackpool Airport to New York <60milliseconds
- Potentially will carry 1/3 of the world's internet traffic between USA to Europe



BLACKPOOL'S FULL FIBRE PLAN

- 13 cities across the UK are benefiting from the first wave of funding from the government's £190m Local Full Fibre Network (LFFN)
- LFFN - The fastest and most reliable broadband speeds available
- Blackpool has been announced as one of the successful bidders for the £95m allocated to successful projects
- An exciting opportunity to make Blackpool the best digitally connected resort in the UK
- Works ongoing at EZ upgrading local fibre optic network to enable high speed connectivity & smart infrastructure
- Future 'Meet Me Points' across Blackpool and Co-operative scheme with commercial Full Fibre Providers to deliver a roll-out programme of new generation full fibre broadband connections to homes and businesses
