

New Waste Regulations for Businesses (2025)

Introduction

The Government's 'Simpler Recycling' reforms require all businesses (10 employees or more) to recycle their waste by March 2025.

- Over ⅓ of all food produced globally goes to waste
- The UK throws away around 9.5 million tonnes of food waste in a single year – even though 8.4 million people in the UK are in food poverty
- Billions of pounds are wasted each year when food is disposed of unnecessarily
